





# **Signed by the Governor**

# HB 2062 Vehicle license tax exemption for PH veterans:



A. Notwithstanding section sections 28-2003 and 28-

5801, the registering officer shall not collect a vehicle license tax or registration fee from a veteran for a personally owned vehicle or a veteran and another party owning a vehicle. The **exemption allowed by this subsection applies only to one vehicle** and only if all of the following apply:

- 1. the veteran is a bona fide **PURPLE heart medal** recipient.
- 2. The **veteran was honorably discharged** from the United States military.
- 3. On initial registration of the vehicle, the veteran submits satisfactory proof to the department that the person is a veteran and a bona fide purple heart medal recipient and was honorably discharged as required by paragraph 2 of this subsection.

\$25 initial application fee/ \$5 annual renewal. Applicant must be a veteran and a Purple Heart recipient and provide a copy of a DD214 or 215, WDAGO forms 53-55 or 53-98, NAVPERS 553 or NAVMC 78, or provide an original letter from the Arizona Department of Veterans' Services (ADVS) verifying eligibility. The initial application fee goes to the Department of Veterans' Services.. May be personalized for an additional \$25 initial application fee/ \$25 annual renewal fee.

Interstate 40 to become Purple Heart Trail across

Arizona

Interstate 40 is changing, or its name is, at least.

Today, a group of veterans will gather in Flagstaff for the official dedication of I-40 as the Purple Heart Trail.

The Military Order of the Purple Heart began exploring the name change in 1996, and Gov. Janet Napolitano approved it last year.

It took the group more than a year to raise \$27,000 for the 10 signs denoting the name. The money came from donations and a grant from the Purple Heart Service Foundation.

The signs will be installed along Arizona's portion of 1-40. The interstate runs from Virginia to California.

In honor of the new name, Napolitano has proclaimed today as Military Order of the Purple Heart Trail Day.

The dedication will begin at 10 a.m. outside of Little America Hotel, 2515 E. Butler Ave., Flagstaff. — Juliette Wallack


