

VIETNAM MEMORY ON NATIONAL VIETNAM VETERANS DAY: This memory is from **Patriot Sal Salinas**. On April 13, 1966, 3rd Platoon of India Co. 3rd Battalion, 3rd Marines, headed south off Hill 55 on a major operation. We crossed the river below Hill 55, for what turned out to be the last time. Lance Corporal Joe Pacheco was singing the Nancy Sinatra hit song "THESE BOOTS ARE MADE FOR WALKING" as we moved down the hill. By sundown, he would be Killed In Action as would Private First Class Alexander McGrothlin and shortly thereafter, the entire 2nd squad, me included, would be wounded and Sergeants Robert Vaden along with Molimau Tela would also be killed. Navy Corpsman Tom Harris came to my aid and performed a tracheotomy with a ballpoint pen, that saved my life! My brother Marine, Charlie Fink carried me to the medivac helo that was called in. All the time we were taking fire. One hour before dark was when all this occurred. I was flown to the aid station in DaNang where I received medical attention. I was then flown back to the United States where I recovered from my wounds at Brooke General Hospital in San Antonio, TX.

As we few, recall this day, raise a glass to all the brave Marines and Corpsman who proudly served an ungrateful nation. SEMPER FI!



NATIONAL MEDAL OF HONOR HIGHWAY:

LTC Dick Tobiason, USA Ret, and Dept of Oregon MOPH member briefed the chapter on the National Medal of Honor Highway that was signed in to law on Dec 17th. He is the creator of the concept of establishing the highway. U.S. Hwy 20 is the longest U.S. highway at 3,365 miles from the Oregon coast to the Massachusetts coast and will honor the 3,526 recipients of the Medal of Honor of Honor. MOPH led the way for the creation of the highway in 5 of the 12 states. 



BILLS IN CONGRESS: H.R. 2081 > The "Donut Dollies Congressional Gold Medal Act." The bill, H.R. 2081, is titled, To award a Congressional Gold Medal to members of the Red Cross Supplemental Recreational Activities Overseas (SRAO) program, also known as the 'Donut Dollies,' who served honorably during the Vietnam conflict.

"These Red Cross volunteers were selfless, brave, and resilient. Every Vietnam veteran I know


members needed it most." 1,120 women volunteered to serve with the Red Cross during the Vietnam War, and 627 of those women worked as Donut Dollies. They provided critical morale boosts to soldiers. Dollies traveled by jeep, truck, and helicopter to forward operating positions, logging over 2,000,000 miles visiting combat troops at remote fire bases. Their job was to bring smiles, songs, games, and a touch of home to the day, 365 days a year to serve veterans, their families, caregivers, and survivors.
