WHEREAS, the mission of the Military Order of the Purple Heart, chartered by an Act of Congress, is to foster an environment of good will among the combat wounded veteran members and their families, promote patriotism, support legislative initiatives and most importantly – make sure we never forget; and

WHEREAS, many Bullhead City residents have been awarded the Purple Heart Medal for wounds received in combat to recognize their bravery and service to our nation; and

WHEREAS, Bullhead City recognizes the contributions and sacrifices of all military service members; and therefore, pledges its ongoing commitment to and support for the men and women who honorably serve our great nation in the military.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that I, Tom Brady, Mayor of the City of Bullhead City, do hereby proclaim the City of Bullhead City as a:

“PURPLE HEART CITY”
