**WHEREAS**, many men and women in uniform have given their lives while serving in the Armed Forces; and



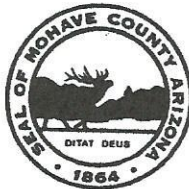
