A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SIERRA VISTA, COCHISE COUNTY, ARIZONA; PROCLAIMING THE CITY OF SIERRA VISTA AS A PURPLE HEART CITY, AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER, CITY CLERK, CITY ATTORNEY OR THEIR DULY AUTHORIZED OFFICERS AND AGENTS TO TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSES AND INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, the Purple Heart is a combat decoration awarded to members of the United States Armed Forces, who die or become wounded by an instrument of war in the hands of the enemy; and

WHEREAS, the Military Order of the Purple Heart, Chapter 572, has requested the City of Sierra Vista to declare itself a Purple Heart City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and members of the City Council appreciate the sacrifices that our Purple Heart recipients made in defending our freedom, and believe it is important that we acknowledge and honor them for their courage; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sierra Vista will demonstrate that honor by creating visual reminders to those who enter the city that others have paid a high price for their freedom to travel and live in a free society.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SIERRA VISTA, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1

That the City Council policy and practice of supporting and honoring our military veterans be and hereby is reaffirmed.

SECTION 2

The City Council hereby proclaims the City of Sierra Vista to be a Purple Heart City, and approves a formal proclamation making such a declaration.

SECTION 3

The City Manager, City Clerk, and City Attorney, or their duly authorized officers and agents, are hereby authorized and directed to take all steps necessary to carry out the purposes and intent of this resolution.
